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### NEW WAREHOUSE ON PORTLAND'S WATERFRONT

The City of Portland, Maine needed to quickly replace an aging warehouse along its waterfront to support local marine terminal operations. With the upcoming summer season fast approaching, the City entered into a contract with Rubb, Inc. to design, fabricate and install a 60' x 100' BVE range structure with an attached 15' x 70' removable canopy.



Rubb, Inc. went to work and designed this structure working in cooperation with the City, local code enforcement officials, and the general contractor responsible for the concrete foundation. All of this was accomplished from order placement to completion in a matter of 8 weeks.



This 6,000 square foot building features metal sidewalls, cargo and personnel doors, a complete lighting package, and a custom 15' x 70' BVR canopy which is removable. The interior of the building features a raised insulated concrete pad to accept a large commercial walk in freezer and a secure bonded warehouse area.
