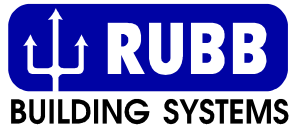

RUBB ASSISTS UNICEF AFTER EARTHQUAKE IN PAKISTAN

Rubb Buildings' associate company in Norway recently delivered and erected a 10m (32.8') x 24m (79') x 3.3m (10.8') sidewall THAB Range Rubb Shelter to UNICEF in Pakistan after the devastating earthquake. This size shelter can store 500 tons of grain.

The THAB range Rubb shelter is ideal for transport as they can fit 5 of these (10m x 24m x 3.3m) in a standard 20 foot shipping container. The shelters can be installed on uneven ground (see photo). This is possible because the shelter is supposed with an integrated steel foundation frame. All necessary tools to erect the structure are supplied with the shelter making it easy to erect anywhere in the world.
